## Personal data confidentiality policy

This Personal Data Privacy Policy (hereinafter – the Confidentiality Policy/Policy) has been developed in accordance with the requirements of Russia's Federal Law No. 152-FL, dated July 27, 2006, «On Personal Data», as well as the requirements of Regulation No 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union dated April 27, 2016 «On protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and free circulation of such data, including the repeal of Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR)».

The Policy determines the procedure for processing personal data of Users and Personal Data Subjects by the Operator when using the websites https://worldatomicweek.com/, https://worldatomicweek.accreditation.ru/ (hereinafter referred to as the Website) and their separate sections/pages (hereinafter referred to as the Sites), and measures to ensure the security of personal data in A5000 LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY (TIN 7708278895, Russian Federation, 129329, Moscow, Kolskaya str. Moscow, 7, bldg. 2, floor 1, room I, com 1 (part), 2) (hereinafter referred to as the Personal Data Operator), in the State Atomic Energy Corporation «Rosatom» (119017, Moscow, 24 Bolshaya Ordynka Street) (hereinafter referred to as the Event Organizer); in PUBLIC LIABILITY COMPANY «CENTRE OF INFORMATION AND EXHIBITION ACTIVITIES OF THE ATOMIC INDUSTRY» (Russian Federation, 115419, Moscow, 11 Ordzhonikidze str, bldg. 40, floor 4, p.4, room I, comp. 3, 4, 6, 7, 9-16, 21-25) (hereinafter referred to as the Event Operator); in Limited Liability Company «Campuz» (18 Demakova St., sq. 202, Novosibirsk, Novosibirsk Region, 630117) (hereinafter referred to as the Event Operator); in Limited Liability Company "CONGRESS EXPRESS" (603089, Nizhny Novgorod Region, Nizhny Novgorod, Vysokovsky Proyezd, Building 1, Office 209) (hereinafter referred to as the Event Operator); in All-Russian Public-State Educational Organization Russian Society "Knowledge" (109240, Moscow, Nikoloyamskaya Street, building 11, structure 1) (hereinafter referred to as the Youth Program Partner); in Autonomous Nonprofit Organization "Corporate Academy of the State Atomic Energy Corporation Rosatom" (109012, Moscow, Kitaygorodsky Proezd, Building 7, Structure 1) (hereinafter referred to as the Event Operator); in Private Institution for the Implementation of Communication Programs in the Nuclear Industry «Center for Communications» (119017, Moscow, Bolshaya Ordynka Street, 24) (hereinafter referred to as the Event Operator); in Private Institution for the Development of the International Regional Network of the Nuclear Power Industry Complex "Rosatom International Network" (123610, Moscow, Krasnopresnenskaya Embankment, Building 12, Block 1, Office 1407) (hereinafter referred to as the Event Operator); in Federal Agency for Youth Affairs (Rosmolodezh) (109028, Moscow, Bolshoy Trekhsvyatitel'skiy Lane, building 2/1, structure 2) (hereinafter referred to as the Event Operator); Beorg LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY (OGRN: 5167746501380, TIN: 7724396261; legal address: rab. 26, room 137, floor 0, b. 42, p. 1, Bolshoi Blvd. (Skolkovo Innovation Centre), Moscow, 121205) (the owner of the exclusive right to the computer program "Beorg Smart Vision: Passports" (Certificate of State Registration of Computer Program No. 2021612726 dated 24.02.2021), used by the Operator under a non-exclusive licence to ensure identification of the Event participants), in order to protect the rights and freedoms of individuals and citizens in the processing of their personal data.

#### 1. Definition of terms

- **1.1. Operator** a state authority, municipal authority, legal or natural person, independently or jointly with other persons organising and (or) carrying out processing of personal data, as well as determining the purposes of personal data processing, composition of personal data subject to processing, actions (operations) performed with personal data.
- **1.2. Event Organizer** a public authority, municipal authority, legal entity or natural person independently organising an offline or online event, which ensures the fulfilment of its goals and objectives within the Event, including determining the purposes of personal data processing, the composition of personal data to be processed, actions (operations) performed with personal data.
- **1.3. Event** a set of actions or phenomena of social life with the participation of a large number of citizens, in the presence of a certain organisation and a certain order of actions (participation), rules of conduct of groups of people united by one socially significant task forum, exhibition, meeting, etc.
  - **WORLD ATOMIC WEEK** International Forum on Atomic and Related Industries (September 25-28, 2025, VDNH, Moscow, Russia) (hereinafter referred to as the Event).
- **1.4. Personal data** any information expressly or by implication related to determined or undetermined physical entity (personal data owner).
- **1.5. Processing of personal data** any action (operation) or set of actions (operations) performed with or without the use of automation means with personal data, including collection, recording, systematisation, accumulation, storage, clarification (update, change), extraction, use, transfer (distribution, provision, access), depersonalisation, blocking, deletion, destruction of personal data.
- **1.6.** Confidentiality of personal data binding requirement for the Operator or any other parties that receive access to the personal data not to distribute nor transfer personal data to the third party without consent of personal data owner, if not otherwise specified by the federal law.
- **1.7. Website** a number of linked together web-pages, located in the Internet and holding a unique address (URL).
- **1.8. Website user (User)** party that performs registration on the Website and/or has Website logon credentials (login and password).
- **1.9.** Cookies small data fragment that is requested from the browser used on User PC or mobile devices by the website. Cookies allow the Website to "remember" User actions. Cookies are stored locally on User PC or mobile devices. Users can erase saved Cookies if they want so.
- **1.10. IP-address** unique address of network access point in the computer network, through which User receives access to the website.
- **1.11. Personal data subject (Subject)** a natural person whose data is transferred to the Operator for processing.

Any other terms and definitions used in this Privacy Policy and not mentioned in this section will be interpreted systematically, in connection with other terms, separate terms, as well as in accordance with the meaning arising from the text of the Policy. If the content of a term or concept cannot be determined from the text of the Policy, the definition of the relevant term or concept shall be determined in accordance with the current applicable legislation or based on the established law enforcement practice.

### 2. General provisions

- **2.1.** The use of the Website by the User implies consent with the current Policy and terms of User personal data processing.
- **2.2.** If the User does not agree with the terms of the Policy the User should stop using the Website.
- **2.3.** Current Policy applies to the Website.
- **2.4.** The User guarantees authenticity of provided personal data.

## 3. Matter of policy

- **3.1.** Current Policy sets obligation for the Operator for non-disclosure and protection of personal data, that User provides upon registration for the event using the Website as well as upon signup for newsletter.
- **3.2.** The list of processed personal data is determined on the basis of the consents of personal data subjects provided to the Operator for their processing.

## **3.3.** Use of Cookies:

- Cookies files, information about the User's actions on the Website, information about the User's equipment, date and time of the session, as well as data from Internet statistics services «Yandex.Metric», are processed by the Operator in order to improve the operation of the Site.
- The User may switch off (disable) cookies, in which case the User may find that some sections of the Site do not work properly. Instructions on how to manage cookies in the browser can usually be found in the browser help service (Help function) or browser settings.

# 4. Purposes, grounds and methods of personal data processing

## **4.1.** Purposes:

- Identifying the Subject, creating an account for the Subject on the Website and providing access to the content and functionality of the Website: in particular, to enable the Subject to be registered as a participant in the Event;
- Identifying the Subject as a participant in the Event and enabling the provision of services related to such events (in particular, the creation and printing of badges, the issuance of passes, the booking of venues where the events will be held, other similar actions necessary for the proper conduct of the events) to the Subject, as well as to allow the Subject to enter the territory where the events will be held (in the case of in-person events);
- Notifying and providing the Subject with the necessary information about the Event and other events (e.g., location, dates, etc.), as well as sending notifications and information and news reports about the Event to the Subject;
- Organising the Subject's transfer to the venue of the Event;
- Providing the Subject with access to the mobile application of the Event.

#### **4.2.** Grounds:

- Personal data shall be processed only if there is a legal basis for such processing, in particular if:
- if the Subject has consented to the processing of his/her personal data for one or more specified purposes;
- the processing of personal data is necessary for the Operator to be able to fulfil its contractual obligations towards the Data Subject or to conclude a contract with the Data Subject;

- processing of personal data is necessary for the Operator to exercise its rights and legitimate interests or to facilitate the exercise of rights and legitimate interests of third parties (including for the achievement of socially important goals);
- their processing is necessary in order to fulfil the obligation imposed on the Operator by the applicable legislation;
- other legal basis stipulated by the applicable legislation.

# **4.3.** Methods of personal data processing:

- Processing of personal data may be carried out both with the use of computer facilities
  (automated processing) and without the use of such facilities (non-automated processing)
  and may include the following actions: collection, recording, systematisation,
  accumulation, storage, clarification (update, change), extraction, use, blocking, deletion,
  destruction of personal data, depersonalisation, as well as transfer (provision, access) to
  persons specified in the Subject's consent;
- The Operator undertakes to ensure recording, systematisation, accumulation, storage, clarification (update, change), retrieval of personal data of citizens of the Russian Federation using databases located on the territory of the Russian Federation.

# 5. Terms of personal data processing

- **5.1.** The processing of User personal data is performed from the moment the User provides his consent for the processing of personal data and during 30 days after the event completion.
- **5.2.** The processing of personal data with aim of sending out notifications and updates on upcoming events is performed from the moment the User provides his consent for the processing of personal data and during during 30 days after the event completion.
- **5.3.** The processing of User personal data can be performed even after the deletion of the personal profile in cases specified by the laws of Russian Federation.

## 6. Rights and obligations of the parties

- **6.1.** The personal data Operator has the right to:
  - advocate their interests in the court of law;
  - provide access to the personal data of the subjects to the third party if specified by the acting legislature (tax authorities, police etc.);
  - refuse access to personal data in cases specified in the legislature;
  - use personal data of the subject without his consent in cases specified in the legislature.
- **6.2.** Personal data owner whose data is being processed in the Company is entitled to:
  - demand clarification of his own personal data, blocking it or erasing in case if the
    personal data is incomplete, outdated, illegally obtained or deemed unnecessary for the
    declared aim of processing, as well as take any actions under the legislature to defend his
    own rights;
  - demand a list of his personal data, processed by the Operator and means by which they were obtained;
  - receive information on terms of processing of his personal data as well as about the storage period;

- demand notification of all parties, to whom were provided his incorrect or incomplete personal data, about all the omissions, amendments and additions made;
- appeal to the authorized authority on personal data owners' rights protection or in the court of law settle illegal actions or inactions on the processing of personal data;
- protection of his own legal rights, including reimbursement of losses and (or) moral harm in the court of law.

## 7. Liability

Operator and Users who violated their duties on Personal data protection, bear responsibility for damages suffered through illegal use of personal data in accordance with laws of Russian Federation.

#### 8. Additional terms and conditions

- **8.1.** The Operator has the right to make changes to this Privacy Policy. The Operator recommends to review the Privacy Policy on a regular basis.
- **8.2.** The Privacy Policy comes into effect from the moment of its posting on the Site, unless otherwise provided by the new version of the Privacy Policy.
- **8.3.** Any suggestions or questions regarding this Privacy Policy should be addressed to the address indicated in the policy details.
